The BBMS PTA is once again offering the STARS program. The STARS program provides monthly treats to the entire staff at BBMS. Staff members who wish to participate will fill out a survey that lists their favorite things. Each staff member will be randomly matched with a participating BBMS family. The family will be given their staff members' survey. Once or twice a month, the family will "treat" their staff member. The family will get their ideas from the survey that was filled out by their staff member. The family will label the treat with the name of their staff member and anonymously place the treat in one of the STARS drop boxes located in the front office and the media center. The intention is to keep the treats small and inexpensive. It's the frequency and the anonymity that is fun. You choose when to send in the treats, there is no schedule. Your staff member will not know who you are until the end of the year when we will meet for an end of year celebration in May 2010.

Staff members are so appreciative of this program. Many have said that receiving a treat has made their day. Again, the items do not need to be expensive. It truly is the thought that counts.
