PALS (Parents Assisting Lunch Shifts): Committee Coordinator(s): Dayna Crisco

Parent volunteers serve daily as door monitors during the lunch periods. Lunch periods are 11:20-1:20pm. The commitment can be weekly, monthly, or occasionally.

Media Volunteer: Committee Coordinator(s): **OPEN**

This job involves checking in and re-shelving books, filing items, helping and interacting with students. The greatest need is from 11:20-1:20pm, although there may be slots at other times as well. Can help weekly, bi-weekly, or monthly.

Volunteers are needed to help prepare or purchase food for events for staff members. Events include the Back to School Breakfast (Aug), Open House Ice Cream Social, meals during conference weeks (Nov and Feb), and Staff Appreciation week (May). Coordinates getting student and staff information for the publication of a school directory. Help with data entry. Help with Microsoft Access. Timeframe: Sept/October.
